Participants will observe nature while considering it a source of inspiration for creative work while getting to see and hear about environmental restoration efforts of the Blue Butterfly Conservancy group.

Kweku Abimbola will then lead participants through a brief journal exercise, dialog and poetry writing inspired by their observations of nature around them.

Participants are encouraged to bring a notebook, pens or pencils, a towel, beach blanket, or beach chair to sit on, along with a light snack and bottled water.
