# Faraday Future to relocate headquarters to El Segundo

- Faraday Future Intelligent Electric Inc. moved its headquarters to El Segundo.
- The 99,200-square-foot office campus includes a data center and gym.
- Proximity to Los Angeles International Airport influenced the relocation decision.

Southern California-based electric vehicle maker Faraday Future Intelligent Electric Inc. is moving its headquarters to Los Angeles' South Bay.

Faraday Future (Nasdaq: FFAI) is leaving Gardena for a new creative office in El Segundo at the end of March. The move marks the company's first headquarters relocation in its 12-year history.

The 99,200-square-foot office campus at 1990 E. Grand Ave. in El Segundo includes private offices, conference rooms, a gym, a rooftop patio and a 1,400-square-foot data center, according to [CBRE](#).

The new space is a step down in size – Faraday's previous office spanned 146,765 square feet at 18455 S. Figueroa St. in Gardena.

Faraday chose El Segundo as its new HQ for its “[exceptional business environment](#), highlighted by its immediate proximity to Los Angeles International Airport,” the company said in an email. The city’s reputation as part of Silicon Beach – a center for aerospace, defense, artificial intelligence and advanced technology companies with ample talent – was another draw.

With the new facility, Faraday intends to support the advancement of its “embodied AI” strategy, attract top AI talent and strengthen innovation and ecosystem collaboration. Earlier this month, the company announced it was expanding its product line to include [robots for the hospitality industry](#).

“By situating our headquarters in El Segundo, adjacent to Manhattan Beach and the greater South Bay innovation corridor, we are aligning our company with a region defined by leadership, innovation and growth,” a Faraday spokesperson said in an email. “The synergy between El Segundo’s technology and aerospace presence and Manhattan Beach’s executive and venture community strengthens our employer brand, enhances our recruiting capabilities, and supports our long-term vision for continued success as we continue to grow and expand.”
