COVID-19 SAFETY GUIDANCE FOR CONSTRUCTION SITES

GUIDELINE MUST BE STRICTLY ENFORCED DURING ALL INSPECTIONS

Contractors, Construction Supervisors, Developers, Job Managers, Homeowners, and anyone else responsible for an onsite inspection:

The Department is very aware that this is a difficult time for many of our stakeholders due to the unknowns/uncertainties of the COVID-19. We plan to provide the inspections required so that your project may be completed timely. However, all inspections must be done in accordance with the City of El Segundo COVID-19 Guidelines (consistent with Los Angeles County Department of Public Health Guidance for Construction Sites-See the attachment). Please be aware that it is your responsibility to ensure the COVID-19 Guidelines are strictly adhered to while the Department's inspectors (and/or other PBS staff) are present at the jobsite in the area to be inspected.

The COVID-19 Guidelines include the following:

- **Maintain Social Distancing** – no more than 10 persons, including PBS inspectors, will be allowed in the area to be inspected and each person must maintain a 6-foot distance from each of the others.
- **Ensure that no one onsite is sick** or is believed to come in contact with someone that has tested positive for COVID-19.
- **Ensure that the site is clean** and that the City of El Segundo inspectors do not have to remove debris or other obstacles to do the inspection.

The Department has informed its inspectors that they cannot do an inspection if the COVID-19 Guidelines have not been followed on the jobsite. They will immediately leave the site and you must reschedule the inspection when the site meets the conditions of the COVID-19 Guidelines.

There will be no exceptions made regarding adherence to the City of El Segundo COVID- 19 Guidelines.

We will continue to do our best to provide you with the inspection services you need and appreciate your cooperation in applying the COVID-19 Guidelines at your jobsite.
