Dear SoCalGas Customer:

In accordance with the federally-mandated Pipeline Safety Act of 2002, SoCalGas will be in your area performing inspections on our pipeline utilizing both northbound lanes of S Aviation Blvd just north of E El Segundo Blvd (City of El Segundo) and two of three northbound lanes of S Aviation Blvd between E El Segundo Blvd and Boardwalk (City of Hawthorne).

Traffic control will occur in stages, so although this work covers two different areas, only a portion of the roadway will be affected at a time. Traffic delays may occur, so I suggest the selection of an alternate travel route around this location during our working hours.

Work will begin around July 11, 2020 and last approximately 2 months.

City of El Segundo working hours are in the evening from 8:30 pm to 5:30 am, however work will begin on weekends during the day from 8:30 am to 5:00 pm to complete the loud activities before moving to weekday night work. **City of Hawthorne** hours are from 8:30 am to 3:30 pm. Traffic lanes will be restored to normal operating conditions when not under construction. Some operations require us to work until completed, so there may be activity outside of normal working hours. We will notify you in advance when this occurs.

The entrance to the park and ride and local businesses will not be impacted. You may also detect an occasional smell of natural gas. The gas service to your home or business will not be interrupted.
