Subject: 2020 Holiday Calendar Dates

This memorandum and attachments is intended to provide information to all City employees about the holiday days off for the 2020 calendar year and to assist Supervisors, Managers and Department Heads with critical information regarding timesheet approvals.

Per City Administrative Code 1A2.139 and Resolution 5197, the City recognizes and observes the following Holiday Dates*:

New Year's Day: Wednesday, January 1, 2020

Management Confidential Group:

Per City Administrative Code 1A2.139 and Resolution 5197, the City recognizes and observes New Year's Day as a City Holiday. Because New Year's Day (January 1, 2020) lands on a Wednesday, City Hall will be closed for operations.

Please note the following for Management-Confidential Group of employees: The City's Administrative Code Section 1A2.139 and Section 1A3.100 provides several holidays throughout the year for City employees. As stated in the Administrative Code "Except as otherwise herein specifically provided, employees are entitled to the following holidays. Provided, however, (a) that in the event any of the holidays fall on the last day an employee is off on his or her regular days off period, the following day is observed as a holiday for the purpose of this section: provided however, b) that in the event any of these holidays fall on the first day of an employee's regular days off period, the previous days considered as a holiday for the purpose of this section. Notwithstanding the above, this provision does not apply to the Fire Battalion Chiefs who receive pay-in-lieu of time off for holidays.

As a consequence of the language in the Administrative Code, depending on the day of the week on which the holiday lands, a determination will need to be made each year as to whether City Hall will be closed for City business.

Notwithstanding the above, this provision does not apply to the Fire Battalion Chiefs who receive pay-in-lieu of time off for holidays.

CEA Group:

City Hall is closed for business, and pursuant to CEA MOU, Article 2.14, CEA employees will receive holiday pay.

SPEA Covered Positions:

City Hall is closed on Wednesday, January 1, 2020, therefore SPEA employees will receive holiday pay.

PSSEA Covered Positions:

Per the PSSEA MOU, Article 2.14 (2) "Police Assistants I/II, Crime Scene Investigators I/II and Police Service Officers I/II, who are required to work on holiday, shall be paid 120 hour in lieu of holidays, on or about December 10 of each year". Holiday pay is calculated at the pay rate in effect on the date of the holiday.

FFA Covered Positions:

Employees who are regularly required to work holiday shall accumulate holiday pay.

New Year's Day: Wednesday, January 1, 2020- Continued

PMA Covered Positions:

According to the PMA MOU, Article 13: Holiday Pay. Section 13.01. C. Employees shall be paid holiday pay at the employee's regular rate of pay. Upon request of an employee and with department head approval, time off may be taken in lieu of holiday pay.

POA Covered Positions:

According to the POA MOU Article 10 Holiday Pay. Section 10.01. Employees shall be paid the holiday pay at the employee's regular rate of pay.

Martin Luther King Jr. Day: Monday, January 20, 2020

Management Confidential Group:

Per Resolution 4153, amending Administrative Code Section 1A2.139, the City recognizes and observes the third Monday in January (Martin Luther King, Jr. Day).

Since this observed holiday occurs on Monday, City Hall will be closed for all operations.

Management-Confidential employees will receive holiday pay.

Notwithstanding the above, this provision does not apply to the Fire Battalion Chiefs who receive pay-in-lieu of time off for holidays.

CEA Group:

City Hall is closed on Monday, January 20, 2020, therefore CEA employees will receive holiday pay, in accordance with CEA MOU Article 2.14

SPEA Covered Positions:

City Hall is closed on Monday, January 20, 2020, therefore SPEA employees will receive holiday pay, in accordance with SPEA MOU Article 8.

PSSEA Covered Positions:

Per the PSSEA MOU, Article 2.14 (2) "Police Assistants I/II, Crime Scene Investigators I/II and Police Service Officers I/II, who are required to work on holiday, shall be paid 120 hour in lieu of holidays, on or about December 10 of each year". Management-Confidential employees will receive holiday pay.

Notwithstanding the above, this provision does not apply to the Fire Battalion Chiefs who receive pay-in-lieu of time off for holidays.

CEA Group:

City Hall is closed on Monday, February 17, 2020, therefore CEA employees will receive holiday pay, in accordance with CEA MOU Article 2.14

SPEA Covered Positions:

City Hall is closed on Monday, February 17, 2020, therefore SPEA employees will receive holiday pay, in accordance with SPEA MOU Article 8

PSSEA Covered Positions:

Per the PSSEA MOU, Article 2.14 (2) "Police Assistants I/II, Crime Scene Investigators I/II and Police Service Officers I/II, who are required to work on holiday, shall be paid 120 hour in lieu of holidays, on or about December 10 of each year". Management-Confidential employees will receive holiday pay.

Notwithstanding the above, this provision does not apply to the Fire Battalion Chiefs who receive pay-in-lieu of time off for holidays.

CEA Group:

City Hall is closed on Monday, May 25, 2020, therefore CEA employees will receive holiday pay, in accordance with CEA MOU Article 2.14

SPEA Covered Positions:

City Hall is closed on Monday, May 25, 2020, therefore SPEA employees will receive holiday pay, in accordance with SPEA MOU Article 8

Consequently, this will impact overall City Hall scheduling and operations as follows:
