<sup>2</sup> The “Case Rate” is the average daily positive cases per 100,000 (i.e a Case Rate of 50 indicates that there are 50 COVID-19 cases per 100,000 total population)

<sup>3</sup> The “Testing Positive” is the percent positive test results of total tests administered
