



# Hyperion Water Reclamation Plant Activities

## Construction Information

The City of Los Angeles Department of Public Works will construct new facilities within the Hyperion Water Reclamation Plant as part of its effort to maintain the site for continuous use. These activities are crucial in ensuring that this plant continues to serve the greater Los Angeles community with wastewater treatment for years to come. All construction activities will be performed within the plant, and it is anticipated that these activities will have very minimal impact on the surrounding neighborhoods.

Some of the construction activities that will be conducted include:

- Shoring
- Beam installations
- Excavation and backfilling
- Sawcutting and asphalt removal
- Pipeline construction

## What to Expect During Construction

- Noise, dust and vibration as associated with this type of construction; mitigation measures will be in place
- The staging of equipment and material will be within the plant site
- There may be off-site staging utilized at a location adjacent to the plant
- Delivery truck usage will be frequent to drop off equipment/material on site
- Delivery trucks will also haul away other material away from the plant, as needed
- No impacts anticipated for sidewalks or walkways that surround the plant
- Schedule is subject to change due to weather and other unforeseen circumstances
