UNPLANNED DISCHARGE TO 1-MILE OUTFALL OF UNTREATED WASTEWATER ON JULY 11 AND 12, 2021 FINAL REPORT SUBMITTAL FOR CITY OF LOS ANGELES, HYPERION TREATMENT PLANT- NPDES NO. CA0109991, ORDER NO. R4-2017-0045

LA Sanitation and Environment's Hyperion Treatment Plant (HTP) is submitting the required final report on the unplanned discharge of approximately 17 million gallons of untreated wastewater into Santa Monica Bay through the 1-Mile Outfall on July 11 and 12, 2021 that was caused by inundation of the Headworks Facility barscreens with quantities of unexpected debris. The final report include spill records, monitoring results, and corrective measures to prevent future occurrences.


