

How To **RECYCLE**

Your Christmas Tree in El Segundo

Curbside Collection

Residents can recycle Christmas trees by placing them at the curb or, if possible, inside your greenwaste cart (if cut in 4-foot lengths) on your regular collection day from December 27, 2021 through January 7, 2022.

Trees over four feet should be cut in half for collection.



Please remember to remove all lights and ornaments before recycling your tree.

Holiday Service Schedule

On Friday, December 24th & 31st, all customer service offices and recycling buyback centers will close early at 3 p.m. Public disposal sites will continue operating during normal business hours on Thursday, December 24th and 31st.

Due to the Christmas and New Year's Day holidays falling on a Saturday, there will be NO DELAYS and all collection will be provided on regularly scheduled service days.

Please Remember to Also Recycle:

Food Scraps and Organics: Recycle fresh wreaths, live floral decorations, Christmas trees, fruit, vegetables, meat, bones, dairy, egg shells, and prepared food in your green cart.

Christmas Cards & Wrapping Paper: Recycle as mixed paper in your blue cart.

Food & Beverage Containers: Recycle glass jars and bottles (all colors), steel, aluminum cans and plastic bottles/containers in your blue cart.

Cartons: Recycle refrigerated and shelf-stable cartons such as soup, milk, juice, soy and other beverage and food cartons in your blue cart.

Styrofoam Packaging: Recycle in your blue cart (no packing peanuts).

Gift & Cardboard Boxes: Flatten boxes and recycle as mixed paper in your blue cart.
