2. Environmental Assessment No. EA-1317 and Zone Text Amendment No. ZTA 22-01 (ES/MA)

Project Address: Single Family Residential (R1) Zones in El Segundo

Applicant: City of El Segundo

Project Description: Amend Chapter 15-4 (Single-Family Residential Zone) of the El Segundo Municipal Code to add a new section that allows subdivisions and allows construction of multiple units in the Single Family Residential Zone, and creates objective standards to implement the requirements of Senate Bill No. 9.

Environmental Determination: The proposed zone text amendment is exempt from further review (CEQA Section 15061), because it consists only of minor revisions to existing zoning regulations and related procedures and does not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Adopt resolution No. 2911, recommending City Council approve an amendment to ESMC Chapter 15-4 to implement the requirements of Senate Bill No. 9.

3. Environmental Assessment No. 1271 and General Plan Amendment No. GPA 19-04 (PS)

Project Address: Citywide

Applicant: City of El Segundo

Project Description: Adoption of the El Segundo General Plan Housing Element for the 2021-2029 period and associated environmental assessment.

Environmental Determination: Pursuant to the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the CEQA *Guidelines*, the City has prepared and completed an Initial Study and Negative Declaration (ND) for the proposed Housing Element update (SCH # 2020050508). The Housing Element and the Initial Study/Negative Declaration are available for review at the Development Services Department in City Hall and on the City's website at: www.elsegundo.org/housing-element

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the Planning Commission conduct a public hearing on the draft 2021-2029 Housing Element and adopt resolution No. 2909 recommending City Council approval of the Housing Element and adoption of a Negative Declaration pursuant to CEQA.
