¹ The “El Segundo Adjusted” indicates the potential active cases of COVID-19 in the City of El Segundo. Because COVID-19 generally lasts no more than 14 days, this number indicates the expected average of current cases of COVID-19.

² The “Case Rate” is the average daily positive cases per 100,000 (i.e. a Case Rate of 50 indicates that there are 50 COVID-19 cases per 100,000 total population)

³ The “Testing Positive” is the percent positive test results of total tests administered
